Alexandria port is the main port in Egypt. It is dated to 1900 BC where the pharaohs established a port west of Pharon and Pharous islands, which was then called Rakouda. The Port area is about 2300 meters long and 300 meters wide. The port has docks with different depths and more than one entrance.

Alexandria is considered to be the second most important city in Egypt. As one of the country's main ports, 75% of Egypt's foreign trade passes through it. In Alexandria there are two ports, one located eastwards called the Eastern port and the other westwards and called Western port. There is a T-shaped peninsula separating them.

These taxis are also registered at the Tourist Police, therefore they are safer than the taxis located outside the gate.**

Alexandria is the second largest city in Egypt. Known as "The Pearl of the Mediterranean", Alexandria has a special atmosphere that is more Mediterranean than Middle Eastern; its ambience and cultural heritage distance it from the rest of the country although it is actually only 225 kilometers from Cairo.

Founded by Alexander the Great in 331 BC, Alexandria became the capital of Greco-Roman Egypt, its status as a beacon of culture symbolized by Pharos, the legendary lighthouse that was one of the Seven Wonders of the World. The setting for the stormy relationship between Cleopatra and Mark Antony, Alexandria was also the center of learning in the ancient world. But ancient Alexandria declined, and when Napoleon landed, he found a sparsely populated fishing village.

From the 19th century Alexandria took a new role, as a focus for Egypt's commercial and maritime expansion. Writers such as E. M. Forster and Gerald Durrell have immortalized this Alexandria. Generations of immigrants from Greece, Italy and the Levant settled here and made the city synonymous with commerce, cosmopolitanism and bohemian culture. Today, Alexandria is a city to explore at random. It is as important to enjoy the atmosphere as it is to see the sights.
