


### Laos' Natural Oasis

#### SONG SAA PRIVATE ISLAND Cambodia



Showcasing hand-made art and textiles by Indonesian craftsmen in every suite, Katamama offers a luxury boutique experience that combines chic contemporary style with traditional red brick design, custom-made furniture and hand-finished details. A 40-minute drive from Ngurah Rai airport, the property is just steps from the buzzing beachfront of Bali's trendy Seminyak district.

Why we love it: Just around the corner from Bali's Potato Head beach club's restaurants, bars, dance parties and art exhibits, the property is a sanctuary of calm. We loved catching up on some R&R at the pool beneath the shade of asam trees and engaging in Balinese healing traditions at the spa.
